 - 1. Will discuss at June in-service days.
- 3. Curriculum development/tracking

 - 1. Spring testing in progress for 2023
- 5. Student achievement LSEM and Special Education programs
 - 1. Ongoing meeting with Mrs. Voigt and Mr. I to discuss the future of the program.
 - 2. Highlighted in chapel this month with guest speaker from LSEM.
 - 3. In the budget for 2023, will determine if FTE's need to be increased.

 - 1. More individual meetings will take place with a few specific teachers with some specific topics and areas of improvement, and goal setting will be guided by the administrator for a few teachers.

- 3. Promote relationship building amongst school families
 - 1. Developed a parent organization PAWS
 - 2. Parent events
 - 3. Talking with families and learning what kinds of things they would most appreciate

Priority 3: Using best practices, equip our leadership in order to provide sustainability for our school ministry

- 1. Tuition development and planning
 - 1. Being reviewed and a new plan developed for building financial stability.
 - 2. The next step would be to answer this question: How can our tuition planning contribute to financial sustainability? Our budget/financials should be presented as an expression of our school's implementation of our mission
- 2. Enrollment and admission procedures
 - a. FACTS online enrollment has been utilized for enrollment.
 - b. School brochures are being developed and will be shared with prospective students.
 - c. A welcome packet is being developed and will be shared when families do their pre-enrollment tour and visit.
- 3. Board development
 - 1. Policies have been written
 - 2. The first board meeting of the year will include board training and discussion about board roles.
 - 3. We will also begin discussions about what the future looks like at St. John during each meeting.
 - 4. Personnel and Parent/Student Handbooks are being reviewed and updated by the school lawyer.
